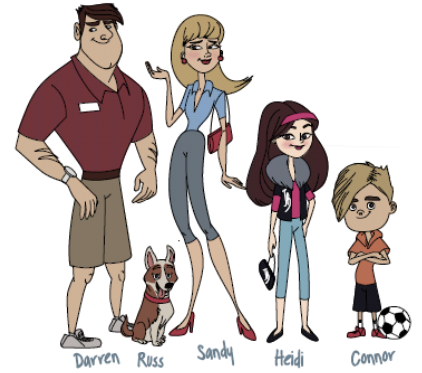

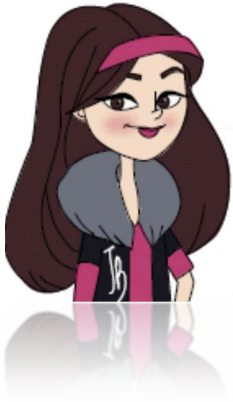
Why Sandy loves living at Highland Reserve
