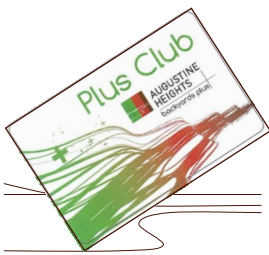
'Backyards plus' Family Fun Day - Sunday 16 October 2011
