

Firms move to park

NORTH Lakes' new business park is taking shape.

New companies will open enterprises at North Lakes at the 85ha state-of-the-art business park, Stockland Greater Brisbane regional manager Andrew Whitson says.

Airconditioning company Snowdonia is already trading from the business park and will soon be joined by additional companies, including Bridgestone and a bathroom and plumbing business.

The business park's first dedicated outdoor recreation area has already opened with the 1.3ha environmental parkland featuring extensive landscaping, picnic shelters, and barbecue facilities.

A second 2.8ha park is also planned for the project and will include recreational facilities and a lake.

Mr Whitson said the North Lakes Business Park would set a benchmark for sustainable commercial development.

The North Lakes Business Park is being developed next to the town centre and is expected to provide about 5000 jobs for North Lakes and the greater north Brisbane region.

Lot sizes in the business park range from around 1278sq m to 6ha with a limited number of lots still remaining in stage one of the project.
