John Robertson, Director of Sunshine Coast architects O.G.E Group said the new townhomes have been designed with careful consideration of all modern necessities.

"Each floor plan has been planned uniquely to its individual location and solar orientation. We have incorporated a generous use of glazing, including louvres, which are carefully positioned to promote cross ventilation.

"The open plan designs provide flexible spaces and each home has its own private front and central courtyards. We wanted to ensure that every home had direct access to the outdoors, with each design integrating both landscape and built form designs to provide seamless indoor to outdoor connection."

The townhomes will be positioned just 500 metres from the new Baringa Town Centre, which includes a White's IGA Supermarket, and offers easy access to retail, cafes, parks and even a future tavern for neighbourhood socials.

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Meanwhile, those with kids will be well catered for with Baringa State Primary School and Goodstart Early Learning a short stroll away, and plans for a future high school.

Playgrounds, parks and community centres are all accessible via 200 kilometers of future walking paths and cycling veloways that connect the home living and greater lifestyle amenities throughout the city of Aura.

On completion, Aura is planned to include two business parks, 10 sporting grounds, 25 community facilities, 20 educational facilities, and 700 hectares of conservation areas and parkland.
