"Adjacent to the City Centre will be the People's Place, an 11 hectare South Bank style parkland which will become a drawcard for residents and visitors from the wider Sunshine Coast region and beyond.

"Aura Central will also feature a future transit centre which includes a proposed train station, numerous community centres, parks and conservation areas and our extensive network of dedicated cycling and walking paths, including the continuation of the Aura Veloway," he said.
