






Rockhampton Centre Overview

Stockland Rockhampton is forecast to service a total trade area population of 232,268 by 2026. The total trade area has an average household income of \$104,136, which is 6.5% higher than the non-metro QLD average, and a large proportion of the population is couples with dependent children at 43.3% in the total trade area.
