Good-looking enough to eat

We eat with our eyes, which is why we gravitate towards food that looks as pretty as a picture. (Yes, Instagrammers, we're looking at you.) Research has found that the more enticing a meal looks, the more flavourful and enjoyable we believe it tastes. So make your first impression count. Even if your cooking isn't up to chef-standard, taking the time to plate a dish well could just be your ticket to winning over dinner guests. Start with something simple: your servingware. Think of it as your canvas. Matte, unadorned platters in winter hues make seasonal ingredients stand out in contrast. Avoid

overcluttering your plate - remember, less is more as it's more pleasing on the eye – but also ensure the portion size doesn't come off looking measly. Follow the rule of odds, that is, grouping food in uneven numbers to draw the eye with its asymmetry. Embrace the theatre of food presentation and unleash your creativity. Consider the angles, create drama with height, and intricately layer to connect all your elements together. For the finishing touch, don't forget to garnish.



A taste of Hong Kong

When you think of Asian cuisine, Hong Kong's local fare probably doesn't spring to mind. But considering it's home to a thriving food scene, including 61 Michelin-starred restaurants, it's about time you put it on your radar. Hong Kong Chef dishes up a menu that melds the traditional (think handmade dumplings and barbecue duck) with modern influences and impeccable plating. "The kind of food we're serving is the epitome of Hong Kong - a curious mixture of Western and Eastern, modern and traditional, radicalism and conservatism," says chef Mr Leung who has worked in top Hong Kong restaurants for more than 30 years.

Commonly called a sushi roll, maki is rice and filling that's tightly wrapped with nori (seaweed). The sign of a well-made maki is one that doesn't fall apart as you bite in.



Gunkan maki

A looser-wrapped version of maki that's hand-rolled into an oval shape, gunkan maki is often overflowing with filling, with special attention paid to

Nigiri translates to 'two fingers', which refers to the size of the rice portion. This style of sushi heroes a thin slice of fish over a dollop of wasabi, laid on a palm-pressed bed of rice


Belgian at its best
