Construction of Newport's stunning Central Park commenced on 12 February 2018. The Park will provide a unique space for the Newport community to play, relax and meet up with friends.

The park will feature two play areas, providing separate spaces and equipment for toddler and older child play. With two custom designed shelters, BBQs and a restroom, it will be the perfect place to host a children's party or family gathering.

A central paved area will provide multiple shaded areas and space for kids to ride their bikes and scooters, and an open grass area will allow for ball games to the southern portion of the park.

Construction is anticipated to be completed by the end of May, keep an eye out for an exciting community event to celebrate the opening of the park.

First phase of lake on schedule for completion in October

Newport is truly taking shape as we create new landmarks and places that ultimately all of Newport will enjoy, including a 22-hectare non-tidal lake.

The first phase of the lake is scheduled for completion in October 2018 when the lake will be filled with sea water.

Ultimately the lake will be 22-hectares, that's 2,000,000 cubic metres of earth equating to 2 billion litres of water.

The lake will be 14 metres deep to allow for deep water, high mast access in and out of the lake facilitated by a lock. It will also feature two shared use zones for light paddle craft.

FUN FACTS ABOUT THE LAKE

• Equivalent to approximately 1,000 Olympic swimming pools in total volume. • Every day, we are removing more than 2 Olympic swimming pools of earth.

• Typically we have 60 machines and 160 personnel on site at any given time.

Nautical-themed park coming to Newport

Exciting plans are underway to develop a nautical-themed playground, including plaza and art installation, at our major Lakeside Park. Construction will commence later in the year. This park will be the centerpiece of Newport's open space network.

A large multi-element playground will provide a wide range of play experiences for children of all ages and abilities, and will include a 10m tall play tower in the form of a yachts spinnaker providing expansive views over the lake and bay.

A plaza positioned centrally in the park will feature public art pieces and interactive water features which will be illuminated at night. Broad turf areas gently sloping down to the lake edge will provide ample space for community gatherings and an ideal spot for future community events.
