8.5km from Grandview

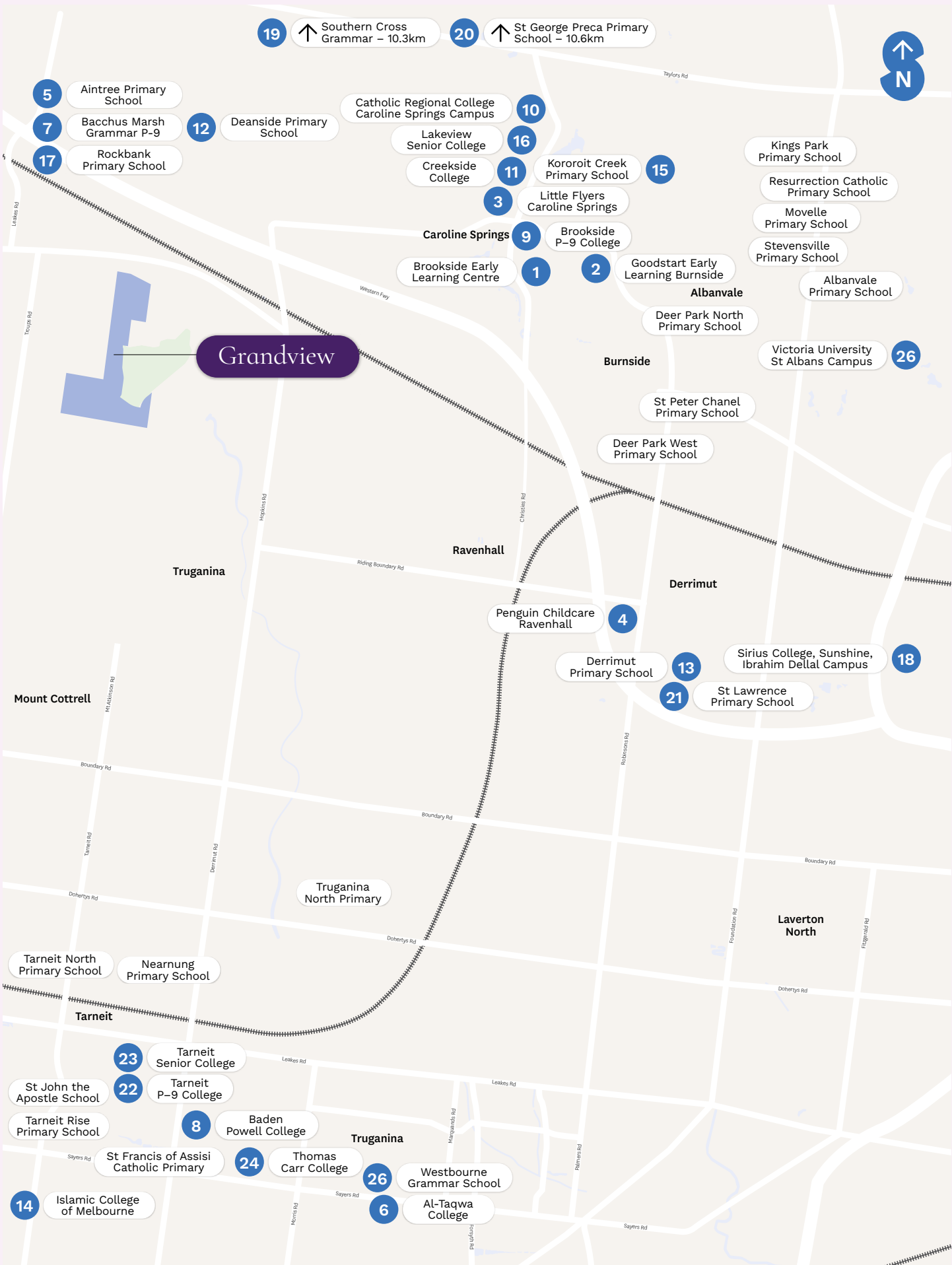
