

Stockland Securityholders Privacy Statement

This privacy statement explains how Stockland Corporation Limited (ACN 000 181 733), our related companies and trusts ("**Stockland**", "**we**", "**our**" or "**us**") collect, store, use, disclose and manage the personal information (i.e. information or an opinion which can be used to identify you, or from which your identity can be reasonably ascertained) of Stockland securityholders.

In the case of investment-related matters we collect personal information such as:

- your bank account details;
- details of your holdings;
- your address;
- your tax file number; and
- details of your appointed as proxies/representatives.

The personal information we hold about you is collected so that we can administer your investment, and is held on the public register in accordance with Chapter 2C of the *Corporations Act 2001* (Cth). If the information outlined above is not collected, we may be hindered in, or prevented from, managing your investments, or processing or accepting your application.

We may disclose your personal information to:

- our related companies in Australia and overseas;
- law enforcement, government agencies and regulators; and
- service providers, contractors and other entities in the course of providing our services, located in and outside of Australia.

The countries in which the recipients are likely to be located include Singapore, United States, Canada, Japan and India. We use a third party, Computershare Investor Services Pty Limited (ACN 078 279 277) ("**Computershare**"), to administer our share/securities registry. Computershare has its own privacy policy covering the collection, use, storage, disclosure and management of your personal information that Computershare collects on our behalf for the purpose of administering our registry.
