STOCKLAND BALDIVIS CELEBRATES COLES GRAND OPENING WITH A FEAST OF CHRISTMAS FESTIVITIES AND FUN

As promised to the community, additional retailers are also opening their doors before Christmas. Crust Pizza is already trading, the much anticipated Nandos will open later this week and Baskin & Robbins, Pasta Cup and Liquorland will also follow suit very soon. Kmart, Best&Less and a new Red Dot will open before Easter, with a full-line Woolworths also confirmed to open by the middle of next year.

Furthermore, 25 new, additional car spaces are now available for customers' convenience, and a total of 1350 parking spaces will be available once the centre's redevelopment has been completed in mid-2015.

Prue Cunningham, Commercial Property Development Manager at Stockland said the transformation of Stockland Baldivis was tracking well with retailers opening on schedule.

"The vision to create a community hub is coming to life. Construction is on schedule, we have an array of exciting new retailers opening soon, and are adding unique elements to the centre, such as our #wallandmalls mural to ensure Stockland Baldivis becomes region's favourite destination for leisure, discovery and fun."

"We're working hard to deliver a bigger and better shopping, dining and entertainment destination for Western Australia's fastest growing corridor. We hope the people of Baldivis are just as excited as we are to see this \$116 million transformation come together."

Stockland Baldivis Centre Manager, Kathleen Brown said:, "To celebrate the launch of Coles, and with Christmas only weeks away, a host of offers, freebies and entertainment will be on over the coming days. We encourage everyone in the local community to join in the fun and celebrations at Stockland Baldivis this week, with plenty more in store in the lead up to Christmas."
