- Establishing a 2.6 hectare riparian corridor and buffer zone, undertaking significant rehabilitation works to restore native vegetation and natural, ecological water filtration systems.
- Implement measures to control and treat stormwater on-site, reducing nutrient loads and slowing the flow of water to reduce erosion of the nearby Eastern Creek.



Altrove – A connected community

- Deliver 1.6 hectares of the site to parks, linking into the Greater Western Sydney parkland.
- · Shared public open spaces, walkways, parks and playgrounds.
- Proximity to existing Schofields train station and planned future rail link, offering residents an easy 50-minute commute into the Sydney CBD and excellent links to Parramatta and the Hills District.
