lack of retail amenity continues to be a real issue for the community, and are working to see what we can deliver in a temporary capacity until the metro corridor is announced.

We have also collated your comments from the recent Community Hub Survey and will be looking to issue a new survey within the next month for your feedback prior to our DA lodgement later in the year. I'd like to thank all who participated in this once again. It has provided us with a number of items to consider and I'm looking forward to hearing your thoughts in the upcoming survey.

## **Community activations**

Due to the restrictions imposed as a result of COVID-19, we will continue to suspend our planned normal events program temporarily until further notice. Instead, we have been busy creating ways for the Altrove community to continue to engage with one another until we can run our regular community events again. #### **Outdoor Fitness Camp:**

## Hilltop Park and temporary community hub update

Following the feedback from the Community Hub Survey, we have reviewed your commentary and are finalising a revised scheme for both the Hilltop Park embellishment and creation of a separate temporary Community Hub space. We will shortly be sending a second survey to both inform and obtain your feedback on the revised design prior to lodgement. A sneak peek of the feedback we're including below:

- 1. Adult exercise stations are in high demand with any additional children's play area to be compatible with the Community Hub and Café uses;
- 2. Kid's birthday parties will be a key use for the Community Hub;
- 3. A Corner Store is definitely desirable in the community – we are working with Council to investigate several options for the delivery of additional small retail in the short term; and
- 4. A clear majority (89%) consider the pedestrian connection a definite necessity.

## **New Home Release**

We are currently working with Council to arrive at a permissible design for the next stage of our development and are anticipating this will contain both townhomes as well as three storey apartments with small scale retail at street level. The next stage allocated for development is highlighted in blue on the aerial image. This will involve an extension to both Calder Street and Altrove Boulevard which will link directly with the new pedestrian connection to Schofields train station (in yellow).

Once we have completed these discussions, we will communicate the proposed design back to the Altrove community prior to lodgement.

Pending Council commentary, we are anticipating to lodge this application by December 2020, with a new home release anticipated in late 2021.

## **Liveability Survey**

The Liveability Survey provided us with some great insight into the Altrove Community.

These are the things Altrove is loving the most:



72% of our residents enjoy the ease of walking or cycling around the community



82% of residents told us they feel part of a community and a sense of belonging



72% of Altrove residents reported feeling proud to live in the community

## We have also heard the key areas in which we need to address to help make the community better:

- 1. Continue to drive the proposal of onsite amenity. As we are unable to progress the Town Centre until the metro line is announced, we are looking to provide temporary amenity in the interim, including a café and community centre.
- 2. Enhance Hilltop Park to include additional features for the whole community to enjoy.
- 3. Develop a plan to keep the community connected through events and onsite activities in particular looking at ways we can integrate educational activities into the calendar.

#### **Construction Update**

#### **Future works**

Our plans for a future Town Centre remain on hold pending the announcement of a metro line by Transport for NSW (TfNSW). We are continuing to liaise with the relevant authorities to facilitate the determination of this corridor. At this stage we can confirm that it is highly unlikely that any announcement will be made in 2020.

## **Schofields Train Station Commuter Carpark**

Transport for NSW have recently announced that they will be fast tracking the construction of commuter carparks near various train stations, including Schofields. The location of the Schofields Commuter Carpark has not yet been determined however we have requested TfNSW to discuss the impacts of any proposed location with the Altrove community.

## **Temporary Amenity**

We will shortly be seeking a second round of feedback from the Altrove community after incorporating your feedback from the first survey. At this stage we anticipate to issue the survey within the next month and lodge a Development Application with Blacktown Council by December 2020.

## Hilltop Park

We will be seeking feedback for the revised Hilltop Park design as part of the survey issued next month and begin construction early 2021.

#### **New Townhomes**

We are currently working with Council to agree on a permissible design for the next stage of our development. We anticipate to release these townhomes for sale in mid to late 2021.

#### **Rosetta Street Townhomes**

We welcomed our final Stage 7 Rosetta Street residents into the community a few months ago amidst the constraints of a lockdown. We trust that you have settled into your homes and the builders are promptly addressing any defects that may have arisen within this time.

#### **Access Road**

We are aware that there is a second location further up the gravel access road which is beginning to collect water and potholes are being created due to the vehicles using the road.

A temporary solution is in place to redirect the water in the short-term. We are currently finalising a design to provide a more permanent solution to the issue and will fill up the potholes once this has been completed.

#### Sales Update

Due to the high demand of land and townhomes in the Altrove community, we have now sold all available townhomes and land. The Altrove Sales Centre is temporarily closed until our next release, with our Sales Professional, Ryan Jennings available on 13 52 63.
