Development Updates

Your future Sportsfield is underway!

We have received our first Construction Certificate from Council, which will allow us to commence works within the next 6 – 8 weeks. The team will work to bring this date forward as we know how important it is for the community. Construction program is currently 8-12 months, and again the team will look to build as efficiently as possible.

Leppington House Park, Ridgeline Trail & Hilltop Park

Bulk earthworks are nearing completion and landscape embellishment works will commence in 6-8 weeks. The park is expected to open early 2022. The development team will provide further updates as works progress.

Denham Court Road

We are excited to report that Denham Court Road is in the final stages of upgrade with landscaping and final inspections taking place by both Council and Transport for NSW ahead of the traffic lights being switched on.
