We are working hard to progress the Development Approval for the Sportsfield with the council. As it stands now, we expect to be providing a field for your enjoyment in late 2021. We will continue to update you on the progress.

We continue our work on the regenerated bushland behind Jamboree Avenue. The plants will need time to establish and grow before this becomes a truly stunning nature trail to be enjoyed for generations to come. The bushland includes a bush tucker trail, natural wetland area, a bird hide and a viewing deck. We encourage you to take a stroll through this new addition to your community when it opens in November.

Phase three of our native regeneration project is underway. You'll notice fencing and a lot of work to the rear of Willowdale Drive towards Willowdale Heights and the P16 precinct. Along with planting hundreds more trees, we will also be providing exercise equipment, walking paths and picnic areas in this space. Stay tuned!

To connect your home with NBN, you can speak with your builder and chosen internet service provider (ISP). Please ensure that you have checked on the NBN website if your area is NBN ready.

If it does show your area as NBN ready, your ISP can start the connection process straight away. If not, please continue to check on the NBN website for updates about availability.

If your ISP asks for an area ID number, or more commonly known as an AYCA number, please contact Stockland, and we can provide it to you.
