## High School Funding

The Hon. Grace Grace, Minister for Education has announced funding for the construction of Aura's first High School

Last month, The Minister announced the State Government's commitment of \$115 million to the new Baringa High School project. Baringa High School will operate with a strong focus on STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) continuing the learning journey from Goodstart Early Learning Centre and Baringa State School in this dynamic educational space.

The high school site is located on the corner of Baringa Drive and Griffith Place, a location that was carefully selected to integrate with the existing education hub and easily connected to the community by the Veloway and extensive network of walking paths.

## **Community Grants**

As part of Aura's ongoing commitment to developing our Sunshine Coast Community, ten community groups have been awarded more than \$300,000 worth of funding under Stockland's 2019 Aura Community Grants program.

The grants, ranging from \$1,500 to \$50,000 aim to support the many local groups and organisations that work tirelessly to make the community a better place.




#### **Aura's Newest Suburb**


