Bulk earthworks are now complete on Stages 1 and 2 and continue across the rest of the site.

Civil works are progressing well on the first two stages, with drainage and the majority of sewer works completed and the first streets starting to take shape. Work on electrical and communication services is also underway and on track to be completed within the necessary timeframes.
