Sales office & Izba cafe relocation

Over the coming months the Aura sales team & Izba cafe team will be relocating to our new home in Baringa, Aura's first suburb.

Our sales team has temporarily moved into the Ausmar display home on Aqua Circuit in the Bells Reach Display Village and will move into our new office on Saturday 24 June. You can still visit us 7 days a week from 9am-5pm. The Izba team closed their cafe on Sunday 30 April and will reopen their new cafe at Aura on Saturday 24 June. This cafe will be located beside Aura's new Adventure Playground. They also have exciting plans to open another cafe beside Quinn Park in Bells Reach by the end of the year.

Quinn Park will remain unchanged and will still be available for residents and vistors to enjoy. We have arranged for temporary toilets to be provided in Quinn Park while the old sales centre and cafe site is being redeveloped.

Baringa's first primary school ready for classes 2018

Construction of Aura's first state primary school is well underway and first enrolments are due to open in August this year.

Educational excellence is one of the key principles of Aura and young minds will be well nurtured in our new community, with land dedicated for the provision of more than 20 schools and education centres as our future city evolves.

Last year, the Queensland Government announced their commitment to build the first school within Aura - a brand new primary school with a focus on Science, Engineering, Technology and Maths. The school is proposed to include a robotics labratory and recording studio along with an indoor sports hall, performance space and music rooms. Once open, the school will also have access to the adjoining soccer fields.

The first classes at Baringa's first primary school are due to commence in early 2018.

VELOWAY NOW OPEN!

Aura's new veloway has been a hit so far with many Bells Reach and Bellvista residents taking leisurely bike rides around the new streets of Baringa!

Work on the second section of the veloway which stretches up to the bus stop on Bellvista Boulevard from the Bells Reach Drive roundabout, has been completed since March 2017. From the bus stop the veloway transitions to a shared pathway

connecting the bus stop with the Bunnings Link pathway.

The veloway will continue to be extended in stages throughout Aura and will eventually connect more than 200 kilometres of bikeways and pathways throughout the city.

Aura residents will live only a short bike ride from everything within the new city including schools, shops, cafes, sports fields and business centres.


Home sites in the first stage of The Elements range up to 716m2, however there will be home sites available up to 1110m2 in future releases.
