Construction begins on Stockland Baringa Shopping Centre

Upon completion in 2019, the neighbourhood centre will include a full-line Supa IGA, 13 specialty retailers, approximately 300 car spaces, and commercial offices.

There are also future plans for a medical centre, swim school and family-friendly tavern.

The centre will be anchored by a 2,000 square metre Supa IGA managed by local operators Michael & Roz White of White's IGA Group. It will be custom-built utilising local manufacturers and integrating the latest design features including a fresh food hall with in-store butcher and baker, an instore café, juice bar and cheese fromagerie wall. Over time the store expects to employ up to 100 full and part time staff.

With the 2nd stage of Baringa State Primary School completed and Council's Community Centre opening in early 2019, the Baringa Village Hub will be a great place for our residents to shop, dine, learn, play and even work!

Road works update

Works are progressing well on the Aura Boulevard extension, with the intersection between McArthur Parade and Baringa Drive now open.

The next section of the road extending towards the Bells Creek Arterial is scheduled to open in early - mid 2019, and the final connection through to the traffic lights at the Aura Boulevard, Baringa Drive & Eden Drive intersection is scheduled to open in mid-2019.

Goodstart Early Learning Baringa opens in 2019

The revolutionary \$3.7 million centre will feature a 952 square metre outdoor play space and provide a ground-breaking STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) focused approach to early learning.

The centre is located directly opposite the new Baringa Primary School, which also offers a STEM focused curriculum, and will offer 132 spaces to local families from birth to kindergarten.

Baringa aerials


What a difference a year makes!

Aura Central update

With the fine weather we experienced over winter, the key lead-in road and bridge have been progressing well. The first bridge decks are on and are transforming into what will be a picturesque arrival across Bells Creek North into Aura Central.

The Shadforths team have laid the sewer and water pipes and construction of roads is underway with the first kerb being poured.

Over the next few weeks, we will start to see progress on the pedestrian footpaths followed by asphalt on the roads. After the roads are complete, work will begin on the electrical, NBN and landscaping installation.

We have commenced the design on the first neighbourhood park. The park will be adjoining the nature reserve and it will complement its natural surroundings. It will include a BBQ area, a playground, a kick about space, toilets and will be well connected to a large path and trail network that will expand as the community grows.
