highly-anticipated and award-winning NightQuarter is now open! Kicking off with a bang on its opening night, the venue has seen extremely strong crowds as locals flock to the newest addition to Stockland's \$830 million Birtinya town centre.

Innovative eats, immersive experiences, live music, experiential artists and local culture. An ever-evolving festival of flavour and sound in a shipping container playground, this is your new weekend destination.

A smorgasbord of food, amusements, stalls, live immersive performances, community activations and experiential spaces. Built from upcycled shipping containers and disused materials, it is home to 40 local makers with global street food eats, desserts and market stalls. It features experiential bars, vintage amusements, a street art gallery, RepairLab and four stages of live music and experiential performances. Village Park Opening

The Bokarina Beach Village Park was opened just in time for the September school holidays! We're so happy to see lots of our local families out enjoying the new playgrounds and BBQ areas.

The new multi-functional park in Bokarina comprises two main areas - the Plaza and the Playspace - and a large open parkland area.

The Playspace provides adventurous play elements such as slides, swings and climbing walls, as well as a lounge net hang out all connected by a rope bridge. Kids will love the button-activated water misting system on the main raised deck to keep them cool come hot summer days.

Did you know the adjacent wetland area, between the Village Park and dunes, is home to some special rare wildlife including the Swamp Crayfish (Tenuibranchiurus glypticus) and the Wallum Froglet (Crinia tinnula)?

The Swamp Crayfish is the world's smallest specifies of crayfish and have unique claws which open vertically rather and horizontally. The Wallum Froglet grows up to 20mm in length and has a pointed snout with a distinctive white streak running from the eye to shoulder area. The Wallum Froglet emits a soft repetitive 'buzzing' call.

You may also spot the Rainbow Bee-Eater. The Rainbow Bee-Eater is a migratory bird and the only Bee-Eater in Australia which is usually seen in pairs or small flocks. Their favoured habitat includes coastal sand dunes, heathland and proximity to permanent waterbodies.

# Future Development Updates

The Bokarina Beach masterplan includes a number of future development sites including apartments, retail, child care and community uses.

Apartments: The Bokarina Beach skyline is set to change over the next 12 months as an exciting milestone was recently reached, with the first tower cranes being erected as construction powers ahead on both Seanna and Oceanus apartment developments.

Tomkins have been appointed to build Seanna, on behalf of Clark Group, whilst Walter Iezzi is delivering the adjoining Oceanus. Seanna in particular will become a unique part of the community, with the ground floor retail offering set to be the first at Bokarina Beach. Both projects are currently anticipated to complete late 2021/early 2022.

DA lodgement on Lot 901: Stockland is pleased to confirm that a development application will shortly be lodged with Council for Lot 901, the irregular shaped site located on Barrel St. Being such a prominent site at the entrance to the community and highly visible from Nicklin Way, the built form design is extremely important to the overall presentation of the Bokarina Beach community. Stockland has accordingly commissioned a striking design by local award winning architects OGE Group.

The site previously was anticipated for a 4 level development with up to 80 units, with short term accommodation the intended use. The proposed development comprises a total of 30 residential dwellings, designed for permanent occupation, in a combination of 3 and 4 level configurations.

The design turns these new bespoke dwellings towards the north - embracing the climate, the sea breeze and spectacular views over the parks and lake. Inspired by lines of sails, wavesets and the tidal ebb and flow, OGE architects have sought to create a memorable gateway to the Bokarina Beach community. An initial artists impression is shown below.

Subject to approvals, construction commencement is currently anticipated for late 2021/ early 2022. We look forward to sharing images of the final design during 2021 but if you have any questions in the meantime, please email us or pop into the Sales office.

# High-performance hub set for Bokarina Beach

Bokarina Beach will be home to the Sunshine Coast's newest high-performance community and sporting hub following council's approval of the Sunny Coast Shred Factory.

The Shred Factory, to be located adjacent to the Bokarina Beach Village Park, is a new concept for the Sunshine Coast. The development includes an indoor swimming pool, indoor and outdoor skate parks, dance and yoga studios, gym, sportsrelated health care services, offices and a café.
