



Quality schools for a quality future

Your children's future is in excellent hands with three modern schools and childcare centres all located within peaceful nature settings at North Shore.

The North Shore State School opened its doors in January, 2018 and is situated in the heart of the community, catering to students from Prep to Grade 6 as well as offering Outside School Hours Care. The well-established St Clare's Catholic Primary School opened in 2011 and now provides outstanding education to more than 700 students from Prep to Grade 6.

In 2015, Townsville Grammar opened its North Shore campus to provide a third excellent option to residents, beginning with an Early Education Centre. The school has since expanded to include additional primary school years and will continue to incorporate additional grades.

The vibrant Petit Early Learning Journey Childcare Centre now has two campuses within North Shore, while a wealth of additional after-school programs operate throughout the community.

For North Shore's youngest residents, getting to school has never been easier thanks to the extensive network of cycle paths and walkways that deliver them safely from their front door to the school gates.

The community is also located close to fantastic secondary schools, including Northern Beaches State High School and St Anthony's Catholic College.

More than 300 hectares of vegetation have been rehabilitated and revegetated as part of Stockland's ongoing commitment to provide a healthy and happy environment not only for residents, but for the region's flora and fauna.


