North Shore State School - Stage 2

Works on Stage 2 of the \$41.8m North Shore State School are expected to commence next year and be open for the 2020 school year. As announced in the State Government Budget 18/19 Stage 2 comprises multi-purpose hall, 16 general learning areas and a three-space science/technology/music block.

Maintenance of public parks

You will notice there has been much needed improvement in the maintenance of the open spaces around North Shore since mid-October. Much of the public open space area has been handed to Council and after some initial teething problems the new contractors are now doing a great job with most areas attended to every two weeks.

Pasco Release

Works on the Pasco Release have now been completed and new homes are already underway. The Pasco release has larger lots, 16m wide and up. Due to the success of the Pasco release, the next stage north of Pasco will commence construction in January with lot sizes ranging from 560 to 678m² (avg 639m²). North Shore Parkrun

You may have noticed new signs installed along some of North Shores footpath network. These have been installed by the volunteers at the North Shore Parkrun.

The 5km North Shore Parkrun is on every Saturday from 7am from the end of the Town Square (off Main Street opposite the Shopping Centre). Its open for any age or fitness level and great way to meet your neighbours and get fit. Registration is free and you will be provided with a bar code. Parkrun volunteers will log your time and your results will show where you finished using Age Grading to produce a percentage score which allows you to track your performance against other peoples the world over even if they are a different age or sex to you and you can track your improvements each week and against other Parkrunners. It's a great motivator!
