MOVING AHEAD AT MAINVIEW RESERVE

With the warmer weather now upon us, work has resumed on Mainview Reserve.

The dog park and walking trails at Mainview Reserve opened in the middle of the year and are proving popular with both Allura and surrounding area residents.

The grass species being laid on the two ovals is dormant in colder months. The recent cooler-than

average-temperatures in Melbourne has caused delays in laying the turf.

Mainview Reserve will be a fantastic sporting asset for Allura and the wider Truganina community, with two full-size ovals, coaches' boxes and cricket nets.

Mainview Reserve is now scheduled for completion in the middle of next year and Stockland is planning a community event to celebrate the milestone.

Connecting Allura – new roads now open

There is good news for motorists at Allura as we continue to build and construct roads to make it easier for Allura residents to get around.

Driving is easier at Allura, with two new stretches of road now open to traffic.

The north-south throughfare Bolivar Road is now complete through to Sayers Road.

The east-west Monet Drive is now open through to Palmers Road.

It is a busy time for road construction at Allura, with other infrastructure projects also underway.

Construction is continuing at the intersection of Forsyth Road and Leakes Road. Work has also started on Forsyth Road South. Both of these road connections are expected to be completed in mid 2017.

Doherty's Creek north

Waterways are an important feature at Allura, with walking and bike paths making them accessible to residents and extensive landscaping to help attract local bird life.

Work on the northern section of Doherty's Creek is underway, with civil and drainage construction nearly complete, in preparation for landscaping to begin early next year.

When complete, Doherty's Creek north will have a similar look to Doherty's Creek south and to Croyley's Creek, which is just around the corner in Allura.

Landscaping on the northern stretch of the creek is expected to be complete at the end of 2017.
