



Development Update

Title registrations

Cloverton continues to grow, now with over 1,100 settlements. The latest stages to register are 314, 315 & 317 in Pinegrove.

Dwyer Street & Donnybrook Road Intersection

Construction is progressing well with an earlier anticipated opening date of May – July this year. The southern side of Donnybrook Road is currently being asphalted, with line marking to commence soon after.

Kalkallo Sports Reserve

Bulk earthworks are nearing completion and on schedule. Landscaping is due to commence over the next few months, with completion still on track for the end of 2020.

Stage 306 Park

After having the community vote on 3 different park themes, the winning creek theme is now with Council to endorse the design before construction can commence. The park is expected to open in Summer 2020/2021.

Dog Park

Cloverton's Dog Park is a fully fenced open grassed area with small and large dog sections. The park includes a water fountain and doggie bags and will have shade added to it soon. We hope the four legged residents of Cloverton are enjoying their new park.
