Development Updates

Title Registrations

It’s been a busy start to the year at Cloverton, with 224 lots from stages 306, 307, 308, 309 and 1203 all anticipated to register in the coming months, which will bring Cloverton’s total to 1,165 lots.



Stage 204 Park

The Stage 204 Park on Bells Avenue will be going out to tender in the coming weeks, with works due to commence in April-May, with completion anticipated for late 2019. The park is designed around a bike theme and will incorporate a bike loop with a bike repair station, playground, a shelter with seating facilities, drinking fountain, fitness station and a kick-about oval.

Pinegrove Village

Construction has commenced in Cloverton’s newest village Pinegrove with the first stage due to register in November-December 2019. The village has a proposed primary school, proposed community centre, local shops and a proposed sports reserve with tennis courts and soccer fields.



St Pet’s Day

Cloverton celebrated St Patrick’s Day with an afternoon dedicated to Cloverton’s furry residents.

The Klandy Street Park became a dog festival with dog washing, agility courses and free vet consultations set up as well as ice-cream and coffee for the parents and entertainment for the kids. Kalkallo Preschool

Kalkallo Preschool has now opened at Cloverton, with 33 families already using the facility. Regional Playing Fields

Tenders have gone out for the civil works of the \$10m Regional Playing Fields with construction due to commence mid-2019. The playing fields will open in 2020 and will include two football/cricket ovals, tennis courts, a pavilion and a district playground.
