
Your place for community

First look at Cloverton's newest park!

Last year, you voted for a creek-themed design for the neighbourhood park located on Camden Drive and Roscoe Avenue in Pinegrove's village. Inspired by the Merri Creek and surrounding nature, the park will include water play areas, a rope bridge, a maze and some quiet relaxation zones. The conceptual design has been approved by council, with the next step being the park's detailed design to be submitted for approval. It is anticipated that the park will be open before Autumn 2021.

Dwyer Street and Donnybrook intersection

Construction of the Dwyer Street and Donnybrook Road intersection is now complete! The new signalised intersection will allow for a safer and smoother journey in and out of the community,
