Dwyer/Donnybrook

Construction works are well underway, with the intersection looking to open between July and September next year. Works on the Southern side of the intersection are progressing well with bulk earthworks commenced and subsoil drains underway.

Title Registrations

Cloverton continues to grow at a fast pace with over 1,050 settlements. Stages 314, 315 and 317 in Pinegrove are anticipated to register in the end of this year or start of next year.

Dog Park
