Visitor Policy Update

Stockland is committed to providing a safe and healthy workplace for everyone who works with us or attends our workplace. We believe that health and safety must always be a business priority, and that we all have a personal responsibility for our health, safety and welfare.

As a proactive response to the global outbreak of Covid-19, Stockland has introduced new measures for visitors to our office locations. These measures are precautionary and have been introduced in the best interests of our staff, business partners, vendors, and guests.

In Victoria, from 11.59pm on Wednesday 8th July, Stage 3 restrictions (stay at home restrictions) apply across Melbourne and the shire of Mitchell. During this period Stockland Sales and Information Centres in these locations will be closed to the general public. Our experienced sales team will remain available for virtual / phone based appointments.

For private inspections appropriate record keeping, hygiene practices and social distancing continue to be in place, and in compliance with the, 1 person per 4m2 and 1.5m physical distancing rules set by the Victorian Government. Visitors will be asked to wear a face mask during all face to face appointments.

Please note that until further notice, all visitors who meet any of the below criteria will be unable to access Stockland office locations:

- a) have travelled overseas (including any country) in the last 14 days all travellers arriving in Australia on international flights are required to self-isolate for 14 days as a directive from the Federal Government;
- b) have been in close contact with someone who has a confirmed case of Covid-19 in the last 14 days;
- c) are experiencing flu like symptoms (fever, cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing)
- d) does not have a pre-arranged appointment
- e) is a resident living in a defined hotspot postcode. Please be advised that photo ID will be required to validate your current address/postcode. We ask that an appointment is arranged to be held over the phone if you live in one of the impacted areas.

In such a situation, we ask that you please contact your Stockland representative as soon as possible so that alternative arrangements can be made to facilitate your interaction (e.g. phone appointment).

Alternatively, office appointments may be re-scheduled following changes to Government advice.
