After two years of waiting, the new \$35.5 million leisure centre at Craigieburn Anzac Park opened its doors on Monday 2nd of October

The aquatic park is expected to attract more than 600,000 visitors a year!



The school is one of four Catholic Primary Schools within the Parish of Our Lady's Parish Craigieburn and Roxburgh Park.

Baldasso Cortese Architects have been appointed to design and deliver the new school focussing on multi-use environments to accommodate a range of needs such as performance areas, arts, science and integrated grounds that is inclusive of passive and active play.

The school will also optimise the potential adjacent recreation reserves and proposed Community Centre.
