## Welcoming new residents Sarah & Jonathon

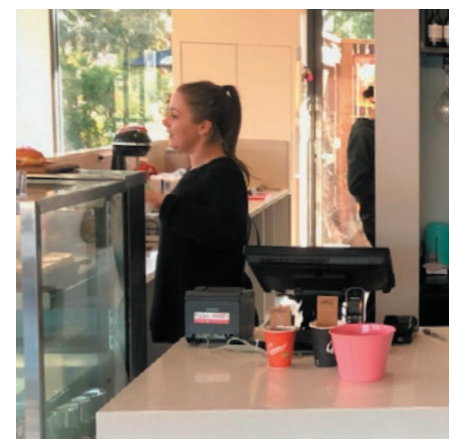

## Development update

### Mt Ridley Road

Upgrade works on Mt Ridley Road between Merrica Court and Highlander Drive have recently commenced and will be complete early-mid 2021. When complete, this upgraded section of road will still feature one lane in either direction, along with a footpath along the southern side of the road and two new road connections to Sustainable Drive and Highlander Drive.
