ANZAC Park projects come to life

The \$35.5 million facility will include a waterslide, 50m pool, children's aqua play zones, warm water pool, spa, sauna and a 24/7 gym with group fitness classes. The building is easy to spot at Craigieburn ANZAC Park, on the Corner of Aitken Boulevard and Central Park Avenue.

The park is designed to cater for all ages and abilities. Little ones can splash around in a special aqua area just for them, kids can play in the shallow pool with inflatables and learn to swim. Parents and young adults can get workouts in at the gym, and enjoy the wet/dry café spaces. The elderly will be further encouraged to dive in with the Hume City Council's active ageing program.

There has also been exciting progress of the Sprint Athletics Track, located along Aitken Boulevard, which has recently been completed. The track at ANZAC Park will be open to the

public between sunrise and sunset and can also be booked by clubs, schools and private hirers. We can't wait!

ANZAC Park also welcomed the completion of the new memorial ahead of ANZAC Day services at Craigieburn. President of the Craigieburn War Memorial & Remembrance Committee, Kevin O'Callaghan, said it was exciting to see the new memorial take shape, standing at over 5-metres tall. "The memorial was really just a small stone about four years ago, but after ANZAC Park opened we received council's support to include a new one into the area."

Funding for the memorial has come from various parts of the community, with Craigieburn Council, Stockland and LeasePlan just some of the contributors.

"So many within the community were involved in the funding and now we're just trying to raise another \$5,000 for final engraving," Mr O'Callaghan said. "The memorial will be a focal point for the 2017 ANZAC Day service at 10am at ANZAC Park and we're expecting about 2,000 people to attend." "It'll be great to be able to access the memorial locally and all year round," he said.



New village

Residents will start to notice activity north of Lakeside and west of Newbury Village on Highlander Drive and Marathon Boulevard. This is a very exciting time for the community, as we welcome the start of development of the brandnew village, The Bridges.

The Bridges will be home to 500 families and will be surrounded by the stunning natural environment of Highlands. It will be easily connected to the existing community, including the community centre, shopping centre, neighbourhood park, active open space and the two proposed primary schools.

There will also be a link to Marathon Boulevard, making access to the nearby Tennis Centre, Aitken Creek Primary School and Craigieburn Park hassle-free. An additional access point on Highlander Drive will lead to Highlander Park and Craigieburn Road.

Highlander Park

The brand new Highlander Park is now open on Highlander Drive and is already proving popular. The park features a range of play equipment for children of all ages, including a flying fox, swing set and a half-court basketball court. Parents will be pleased to know there are multiple shaded picnic areas, along with a lovely green kick-about area. Take the family down and enjoy an afternoon of adventure!

Construction update

There has been a lot of construction activity at Highlands over the last six months and we thank you for your patience!

Approximately 400 lots have been built on across seven stages and in three different villages, so we are proud to welcome many new residents to the Highlands community.

Construction has now started on stages 211, 284, 323, 219, 244, 318 and 322, all of which are due to be completed between March and July this year. Stage 221 has also started construction and is due to be completed between September and December 2017. Stages 245, 288 and 222 are awaiting approvals and will commence construction upon approval with completion due between September and December this year.









Eastside at **Highlands**


