## Construction update

#### Stages 1-2:

Construction of road infrastructure has commenced, with the future road network mapped out and earthworks on access ways underway. First registrations are expected in February - March 2020.


#### Stage 3:

Sewer and stormwater drainage services are currently in progress which will be followed by road construction. Registrations are expected in April - June 2020.

#### Stages 5-6:

Earthworks have commenced to ensure the ground is levelled and compacted before sewer and drainage construction begins. Registrations are expected May - July 2020.


