As your nature strip landscape is typically installed before your home is constructed, it is important you ensure that any damage as a result of the construction of your home is addressed by your builder before they finish construction.

Once your home has been built, the rectification of any damage to your nature strip that occurred during the construction of your home is your responsibility.

The Address Central Park

Stockland is working with Wyndham City Council to deliver a two hectare park located in the centre of The Address.

We're excited to share the plans for Central Park which have just been approved by council.

A sculptural feature element will travel through the central spine of the park, featuring a large central shade area and play spaces on both sides.

Two large, turfed spaces flanked by trees and garden beds on the edges will provide a sense of grandeur.

Landscape works on the park will commence early this year.
