At 78, Denis Davis demonstrated he is in peak shape after completing Melbourne's Eureka Stair Climb in an impressive 34 minutes and 44 seconds.

As a Stockland Donvale Retirement Village resident, Denis' story is reflective of the recent Stockland Social Return on Investment report

showing that their retirement living residents are 80 per cent less likely to call an ambulance or visit the emergency department and have 86 per cent fewer mental health consultations.

"I have been active my whole life and I am extremely happy with my achievement," he said.

"The support from many of the Stockland Donvale residents before and after the event was overwhelming. I feel very humbled and honoured by the experience," Denis said.

The climb was for a good cause and Denis raised \$1,244.40 for the Fred Hollows Foundation.
